Mid-Century style marquetry panel depicting a seaside-coastal scene inlaid from small pieces of exotic wood veneer, hand-crafted in Italy. Marquetry is a French word, meaning "inlay work." Italian revival of veneered marquetry began in 16th century Florence and at Naples. It was originally developed in Antwerp, prior to being imported to France, then Italy. The craft has since evolved using multiple different techniques and disciplines. Marquetry as a modern craft is becoming rarer and harder to find, today it's most commonly produced on furniture pieces. A charming found piece of Italian hand-crafted art, a special piece to cherish and pass on for generations.
